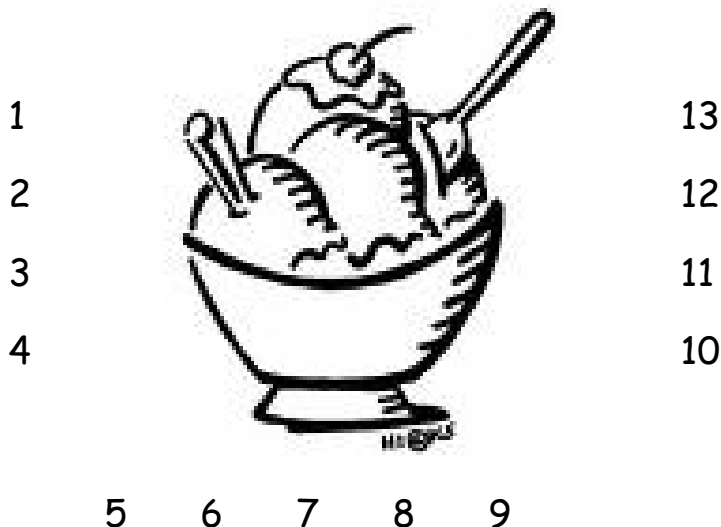
Speaking in regards to memorizing the Articles of Faith, Elder L. Tom Perry said the following:
