

Joseph Smith Tic Tac Toe

Print out the Tic-Tac-Toe board. Print out the questions, cut out and put in a container. Have two teams. Team X picks a square for their X. Someone from team O picks a question. They answer the question— but they can give the right answer or make up an answer. Team X decides whether it is correct or incorrect. If team X guesses correctly they place their X on the square they asked for before the question was asked. If incorrect, the other team gets their O in that square. Then it is O's turn to pick a square and team X picks a question to answer – etc. The first team to go across the board up, down or diagonally wins.

Number of times Moroni visited Joseph in his bedroom. (3)	Name the river Joseph was baptized in. (Susquehannah)	What part of Joseph's body was operated on when he was 7 years old? (leg)
He was candidate for this political office in 1844. (President of the United States)	State in which Joseph was born. (Vermont)	What year was he killed? (1844)
How many pages did he give Martin Harris, who then lost them? (116)	Full name of his wife. (Emma Hale Smith)	Season and year of the First Vision (Spring of 1820)
Who died with Joseph in Carthage? (Hyrum Smith)	How many children did Joseph and Emma have? (11)	What is the exact date he organized the Church? (April 6, 1830)
What are the two major places Joseph was imprisoned? (Liberty and Carthage)	Name both of Joseph's parents. (Lucy Mack Smith and Joseph Smith, Sr.)	How long did Joseph serve as President of the Church? (12 1/2 years – 1/1832 to 6/1844)
