





Jesus Toilet Paper Roll Puppet

- 1. Color and cut out puppet. 2. Fold up feet.
- 3. Glue around an empty toilet paper roll.
- 4. Use with boat, water, and Peter to act out the story of Christ walking on the water © www.scriptures4kids.com


Peter had Jaith and walked on water.




- 3. Glue around an empty toilet paper roll.

1. Boat Sides - cut across dotted lines for the boat seat then glue a thin piece of the sides together at each end. Bottom and top should be open.




Glue boat sides first before moving onto other steps.



2. Boat Seat - Fold in half along dashed line and glue together. Fold down side pieces along dashed line then glue to the inside of the boat about half way down.

3. Boat Bottom - cut along dotted lines, fold up flaps and glue to the bottom inside of the boat sides. The bottom should be centered between the boat sides.








People came to listen to the prophet in their family tents.







Christ tells President Monson what to teach his people.
