1. How many values are there and what are they? (8 values—Faith, Divine Nature, Individual Worth, Knowledge, Choice & Accountability, Good Works, Integrity, & Virtue)
2. What color represents the value of divine nature? (blue)
3. What is the newest value and when was it announced? (Virtue, November 28, 2008)
4. What color represents the value of individual worth? (red)
5. What does virtue mean? (to have the moral courage to make actions consistent with my knowledge of right and wrong—to be honest with yourself and others—to do the right thing even when no one is watching)

2. The Young Women logo is a torch surrounded by the Young Women motto. What does the logo mean? (the torch represents the light of Christ, inviting all to "come unto Christ". It invites all young women to make a commitment to hold up their light by being an example and remaining worthy to make and keep sacred covenants and receive the ordinances of the temple.)
3. What are the 3 different symbols for Beehive, Mia Maid, and Laurel? (beehive, rose, laurel wreath)
4. You can earn an Honor Bee after completing your personal progress experiences and projects. What are the 2 requirements for earning an honor bee? (read the Book of Mormon again, serve others for a total of 40 hours (part of these hours should be used in helping someone else with personal progress))
5. Who said the following? "Give me a young woman who loves home and family, who reads and ponders the scriptures daily, who has a burning testimony of the Book of Mormon. Give me a young woman who faithfully attends her church meetings, who is a seminary graduate, who has earned her Young Womanhood Recognition Award and wears it with pride!
