Subject Transportation Safety in Youth Activities

The *Church Handbook of Instructions* explains Church policy regarding travel, use of seat belts for each passenger, and insurance coverage. Stake presidents and bishops are encouraged to review the following information in stake and ward councils and emphasize the importance of safety and appropriateness in activities:

Plan Activities That Are Safe and Appropriate	Book 2, 271
Church Activity Insurance Program	Book 2, 277-78
Parental Permission	Book 2, 278
Travel (including commercial and private liability insurance)	Book 2, 279-80

All leaders of youth and young adults should also use the Activity Plan (33809) and Parental or Guardian Permission and Medical Release (33810), available from the Church Distribution Center, when organizing activities.
