




- When Jesus Christ lived on the earth he had friends who loved him very much.



- These friends followed him and listened to his teachings.



- Because they did what he taught them to do, they were called his disciples.



Jesus loved his disciples.



He helped them learn what they needed to do to live with him and Heavenly Father again.



He helped them understand the difference between right and wrong so they could choose the right.



Remember a few weeks ago we learned about Jesus being resurrected.

We talked about how, after he was resurrected, Jesus visited his disciples.



Jesus visited and taught his disciples for forty days after he was resurrected
(see Acts 1:3).



He wanted to be sure they knew he was alive again and understood his teachings.



Jesus wanted his disciples to obey his teachings even when he was no longer with them.





After He was resurrected, Jesus stayed with His Apostles for 40 days. He taught them many things about the gospel and His Church.



He told them to teach the gospel to all people. He also said that He would leave them soon, but the Holy Ghost would come to help them.



The Apostles watched Jesus go up into the clouds. Two angels in white clothes told the Apostles that Jesus would come back from heaven someday.



Before he left, Jesus gave his disciples a blessing.



Jesus left his disciples and rose up into a cloud to join Heavenly Father in heaven.



The disciples stood and watched until
Jesus disappeared.



As the disciples stood looking up toward heaven, two angels dressed in white appeared beside them.

- 11 . . . why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.



The angels told the disciples that Jesus Christ would someday come back to earth in the same way he left, we refer to this as the Second Coming.



We do not know exactly when Jesus will
come again.



Only Heavenly Father knows the exact time (see Matthew 24:36).



But we do know that someday Jesus will return to the earth to live.



When Jesus comes again he will live among the people on earth.



Everyone will know
that he is Jesus
Christ, our Savior,
and will worship
him.







- We should all want to follow the teachings of Jesus so we can have the privilege of seeing him when he comes again.


